# Group 1 Activity

- **Our city has seen an increase in extreme weather events leading to loss of life and major disruption in the transportation system. Local elected officials have asked transportation leaders to do better in terms of planning for and responding to major events.**

# Group 2 Activity

- **A major arterial corridor connecting near in suburbs to downtown is experiencing changes in land use patterns and increases in regional through traffic. Community members want to see more infill and redevelopment, but the corridor also serves as a critical commuting link to downtown. There are competing visions and values driving the planning process.**

# Group 3 Activity

- **Downtown business leaders and elected officials want to ensure a long term strategy to support multimodal access and mobility in a congested downtown. These leaders want to explore how Connected and Autonomous Vehicles (CAV) could be part of a long term strategy to improve transportation in downtown.**
