Data Tables Specifications for 2012 – 2016 CTPP Tabulation



Census Bureau Guidance:

- The Census Bureau asked the CTPP Oversight Board to reduce the proposed 2012 – 2016 tabulation by 2/3 and to reduce the number of tables produced at all geographies.
- A CTPP "Tables Subcommittee" began to tackle this issue in May 2014.



- A CTPP "Tables Subcommittee" composed of a diverse group of data users began to tackle this issue in May 2014:

Table will be produced at "All Geographies" and "Large Geographies Only"

- "Large Geographies" tables will include:
 - »Nation
 - »State
 - »County
 - »Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA)
 - »Principal City
 - »Place
 - »Public Use Microdata Area (PUMA)
 - »Municipal Civil Division (MCD, for 12 strong MCD states)
 - »Traffic Analysis District (TAD)

- Tables produced for "All Geographies" will also include data produced at:
 - » Census Tract
 - » Traffic Analysis Zone (TAZ)



- Some tables will still include "perturbated data" ("B Tables"):
 - Most Flow Tables
 - Means of Transportation
 - Aggregate HH Income, Carpools Tables

- 176 Tables will be deleted from the new tabulation.
- 8 new tables will be tabulated:
 - Part 1, Place of Residence Tables:
 - Mean Number of Persons per Household
 - Poverty Status (4) by Means of Transportation (11)
 - Part 2, Workplace Tables:
 - Poverty Status (4) by Means of Transportation (11)
 - Class of Worker (9) by Industry (15)
 - Class of Worker (9) by Time Arriving (17)
 - Class of Worker (9) by Mean Travel Time (1)
 - Class of Worker (9) by Means of Transportation (7)
 - Part 3, Home to Work Flow Tables:
 - Vehicles Available in Household (5) by Number of Workers in Household (6) ("Vehicle Sufficiency")

- Some tables will not be requested from the Census Bureau but will be created in the access software (for example, "collapsed" tables.

Methodology for Determining Tabulation Proposal:

- CTPP access software was analyzed to determine how many times each Table was accessed since 11/1/2013.
 - (This did not include "Power Users" who download full or full state CTPP data for analysis.)
- CTPP Oversight Board members, Users, CTPP listserve were polled for which tables should be retained and which should include "All Geographies."
- Town hall meetings were held November 2015
 - Approximately 75 attendees

Responses were collected and various criteria were reviewed:

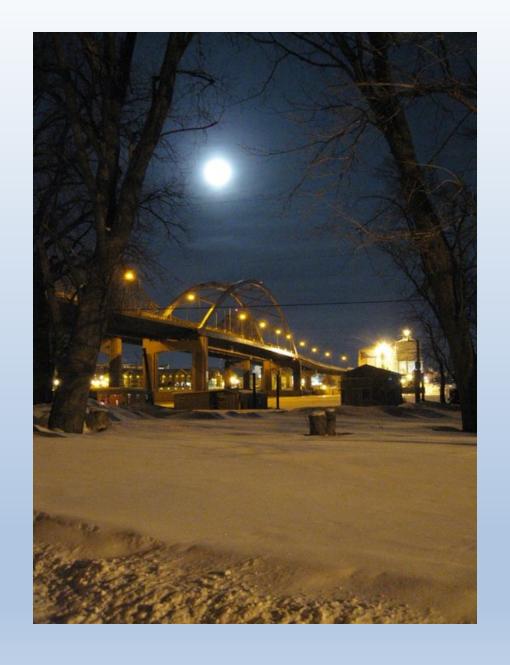
Final criteria for table elimination were developed:

- Tables that have been accessed 150 times or fewer by 11/6/2015.
- Tables that had 5 or more recommendations for elimination by committee members.

Tables that were not slated for elimination but that had two or fewer recommendations to retain "All Geographies" were proposed as "Large Geographies Only."

Where do we go from here?

- The tabulation proposal was approved by the full CTPP Oversight Board on May 10, 2016.
- The proposal has been submitted to the Census Bureau for tabulation.
- The Census Disclosure Review Board (DRB) has approved the tabulation (August, 2016)
- Data access software with the new 2012 2016 CTPP tabulation will be available in 2018 (or early 2019).
