The Transportation Research Board, and the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) Census Transportation Planning Products (CTPP) program Oversight Board are hosting a conference entitled Applying Census Data for Transportation: 50 years of Transportation Planning Data Progress. The conference will explore current research; provide an opportunity for sharing experiences; examine strategies for data improvements; reflect on previous successes; and explore census data needs for the future.

To advance the conference agenda, the Planning Committee is seeking one-page abstracts on the use of census data and census-based applications in transportation for presentation and/or as a poster. Potential topics can include uses of:

- American Community Survey (ACS) data
- Census Transportation Planning Products (CTPP)
- Public Use Microdata Sample (PUMS)
- Census Application Programming Interface (API)
- Big Data in combination with Census Data
- Other transportation data-related topics will be considered

Submission Process:

Please submit your abstracts electronically at <https://s.zoomerang.com/r/Censustrans> and limit your abstract to no more than 400 words by **May 25, 2017**.

Final enhanced abstracts for publication in the conference proceedings will be due by **October 15, 2017**. Enhanced abstracts may be up to **1,200 words or two pages**. Complete papers may also be submitted.

All submitters will be notified via email by **June 26, 2017**. Authors whose abstracts are accepted will be asked to confirm their conference registration and attendance by **July 18, 2017**.

When submitting your abstract, be prepared to enter the Author(s) Name(s), contact information and biographical information in not more than 100 words including title, agency or firm, and any other information deemed pertinent. Submitters will also be asked to identify if they have a preference for their work to be considered as a poster or presentation.
