



MARINE BOARD 2011 CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Marine Board of the National Research Council is seeking nominations for new members to be appointed to 3-year terms that would commence on 1 November 2011.¹ The Marine Board serves the nation and its sponsoring federal agencies by providing technical and policy evaluations and advice. Board members are appointed by the Governing Board of the National Research Council based on experience and expertise in areas of current interest to the Board and its sponsors. Members serve without compensation in the national interest. The 20-member Board meets twice a year and members represent a broad diversity of background, expertise, experience and subject knowledge. The topics/issues of highest current interest include: Arctic shipping, safety in offshore operations, risk assessment and risk management, port and maritime security, inland and coastal shipping, environmental effects of marine transportation and port operations, and shipping safety.
