


SHRP 2

- Authorized by Congress \$232 million; 9 years
- Targeted, short-term program of strategic highway research
- Administered by TRB under MOU with FHWA and AASHTO
- Integrates multiple disciplines to address critical needs in 4 areas



SHRP 2



Analysis Priorities

- Roadway departure, especially on rural roads
- Intersection crashes
- Driver characteristics, behavior, and performance frequency, relation to crash risk, and potential countermeasures
- Driver interaction with advanced vehicle technology



Two Phases

Phase I: Preliminary Proof-of-Concept Analysis

- 11 mo.
- \$100,000 for each contract, excluding data file preparation and user support from VTTI
- Multiple awards anticipated

Phase II: Full Analysis

- 20 mo.
- \$ TBD
- Phase II projects will be selected based on merit, cost and coverage of priority topics.
