
Public Transportation is a Climate Solution




A typical trip on public transit emits
55% fewer greenhouse gas emissions
than driving or ridehailing alone.

Did you know?

- Public transportation is a low-carbon solution for passengers, and it has gotten better over time.
- Emissions per passenger mile in 2018 were 26% lower than in 2005.
- Transit kept pace with auto efficiency improvements over the last decade.
