

REPORT OF SUB-COMMITTEE  
ON  
ROADSIDE DEVELOPMENT COST RECORDS

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Because the work of the Sub-committee on Roadside Development Cost Records is expected to cover a much wider field of study than costs, it has been decided to change its name to the Sub-committee on Roadside Development Economics.

The present function of this Sub-committee is to assemble data on cost of roadside development work and to make this information available in a form that can be used by the different State highway departments.

It is intended that the reports of this Sub-committee shall so classify items of roadside development work that comparison will be possible under changing conditions. Its reports should show that roadside development in many cases is a means of saving future construction and maintenance cost through soil erosion control and back-slope protection.

Findings can be valuable in preparing suggested uniform report forms and cost records. Data should show construction and maintenance costs by units. Costs of preparing plans, overhead replacement costs, and methods of financing projects will also be studied.
