

The TRB Committee on Managed Lanes/HOV Systems will be hosting this webinar on March 18, 2008 on Recent Advances in Managed Lanes Networks. Managed Lanes are now being considered more on a system-wide level to address regional mobility and compound travel time benefits by linking individual facilities. The speakers will present their perspectives on how managed lanes are being considered at a multi-facility and/or a regional level. These systems are likely to incorporate multiple management strategies including occupancy (HOV), pricing, truck usage, time-of-day variants, BRT, etc. The purpose of the webinar is to share experiences and lessons learned from around the country.
