The goal of our project is to validate established exercise scenarios with the airport community.

#### Exercise objectives:

- Apply NIMS/ICS response protocols in airport emergency situations
- Determine the correct degree of response, at the correct time, during an emergency
- Differentiate important from unimportant information during a crisis
- Describe the process for closing down the EOC
- State how incoming and outgoing information should flow during a crisis
- Define the roles and duties of the personnel around them
- Describe the actions that promote effective planning during an emergency

#### Available scenarios:

- Airport fuel farm fire
- Bomb threat
- Terminal fire
- Hazardous materials release
- November storm
- Power failure
- Sabotage
- Water rescue
- Mass Casualty Accident

- Train staff using realistic emergency response scenarios
- Prepare for your next full-scale exercise
