



COVID Health and Safety Policies

Please be advised that a risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any event or public space, including the TRB Annual Meeting.

By attending the TRB Annual Meeting, you acknowledge and confirm each of the following applicable health and safety guidelines:

- That you will abide by all health-and-safety protocols of Centers of Disease Control (CDC), Transportation Research Board (TRB), and the National Academy of Sciences (NAS);
- That you are fully vaccinated for COVID-19, meaning that at least two weeks have passed since you received either a one-dose vaccine or the second dose of a two-dose vaccine;
- That you will wear a protective mask at all times during the Annual Meeting, except when actively eating or drinking, or when speaking from a lectern that's at least 6' from others;
- That you are not currently experiencing any of the following symptoms of COVID-19: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea;
- That, prior to attending the TRB Annual Meeting, you have not been in contact with someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 symptoms without completing a 5-day quarantine; and
- That you are not under any self-quarantine orders.
